Progress

- Population and Housing Census 2015
- Lao Social Indicator Survey 2017
- Local statistics System (Village Statistics) 2019
- Civil Management Information System (CMIS) is piloting in 3 provinces and 31 districts.
- Improve District Health Information System (DHIS) with accurate, complete, and timely data on births and deaths including causes of deaths.

Action Plan

- CRVS database from administrative report System (Village Statistics system);
 - CMIS set up at all provinces;
 - Data sharing with MOHA and relevant organization;
 - Annually report of CRVS;
- Conduct Lao Inter-Census Population Survey 2020 (LIPS);
- Conduct Social Indicator Survey 2022 (LSIS).
- Updated CRVS database base on CMIS, LIPS, VSS, & LSIS III;
- Data sharing with relevant ministries (CRVS database);
- Conduct Population and Housing Census 2025;
- Conduct Lao Social Indicator Survey 2027;
- Annually report of CRVS;
- Everyone are counted.

Challenges

- Limitation of skilled staff for an appropriate professional such registration skills and ICT at local level;
- Limited financial resources for full coverage and implementation of efficient CRVS system;
- Distribution of CRVS roles and responsibilities should be clear;
- Insufficient attention to at-risk groups and populations.
