

Background information

- ▶ 811km2 land area vs 3.5 million km2 ocean
- > 110,000 (2015 Census)
- Atoll Islands
- 33 habited islands
- Economy dependent on fisheries and remittances





Civil registration in Kiribati

- The Civil Registration office is responsible for registration of all births, deaths and marriages in the Republic of Kiribati.
- Birth, death and Marriages Act of Kiribati (Cap 5 and Cap.54)
- Establishment 1980
- Computerized system
- Collaboration with Ministry of Health and Island Clerks

Our Services

- Birth registrations (including late registrations)
- Death registration

Awareness program - for both registrations

Birth registration completeness (provide year of data)

Age Group	Total number of Birth (2012 - 2014)	Census 2015	Completeness
0-5 (CRO)	7218	8447	85%
0-5 (MoH)	7839	8447	93%

Death registration completeness (provide year of data)

	Census 2015	Deaths registered (year)	Completeness (%)
All ages (CRO)	2509	1882	75 %
All ages (MoH)	2509	1878	74.8%
